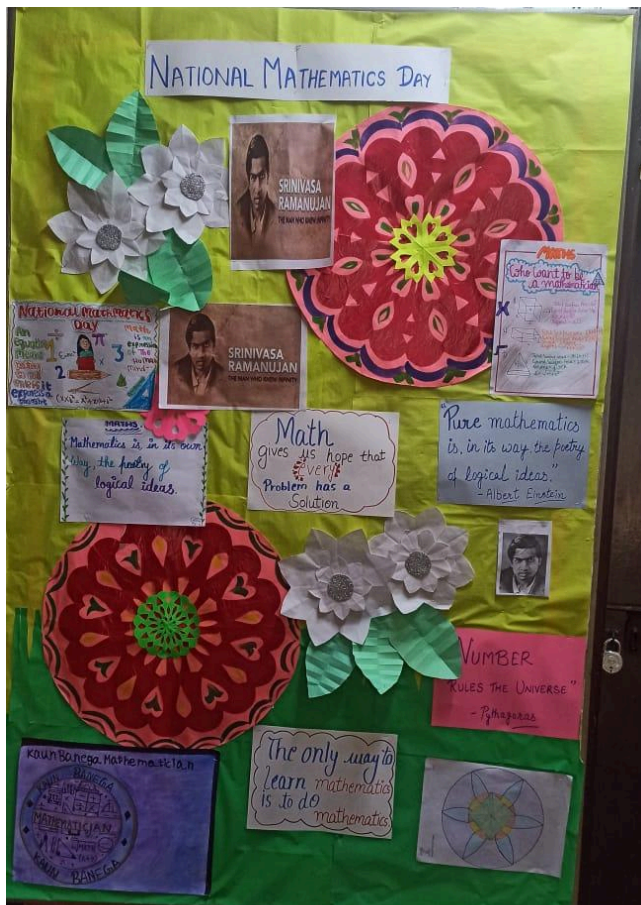
Day 2 – 19th December
