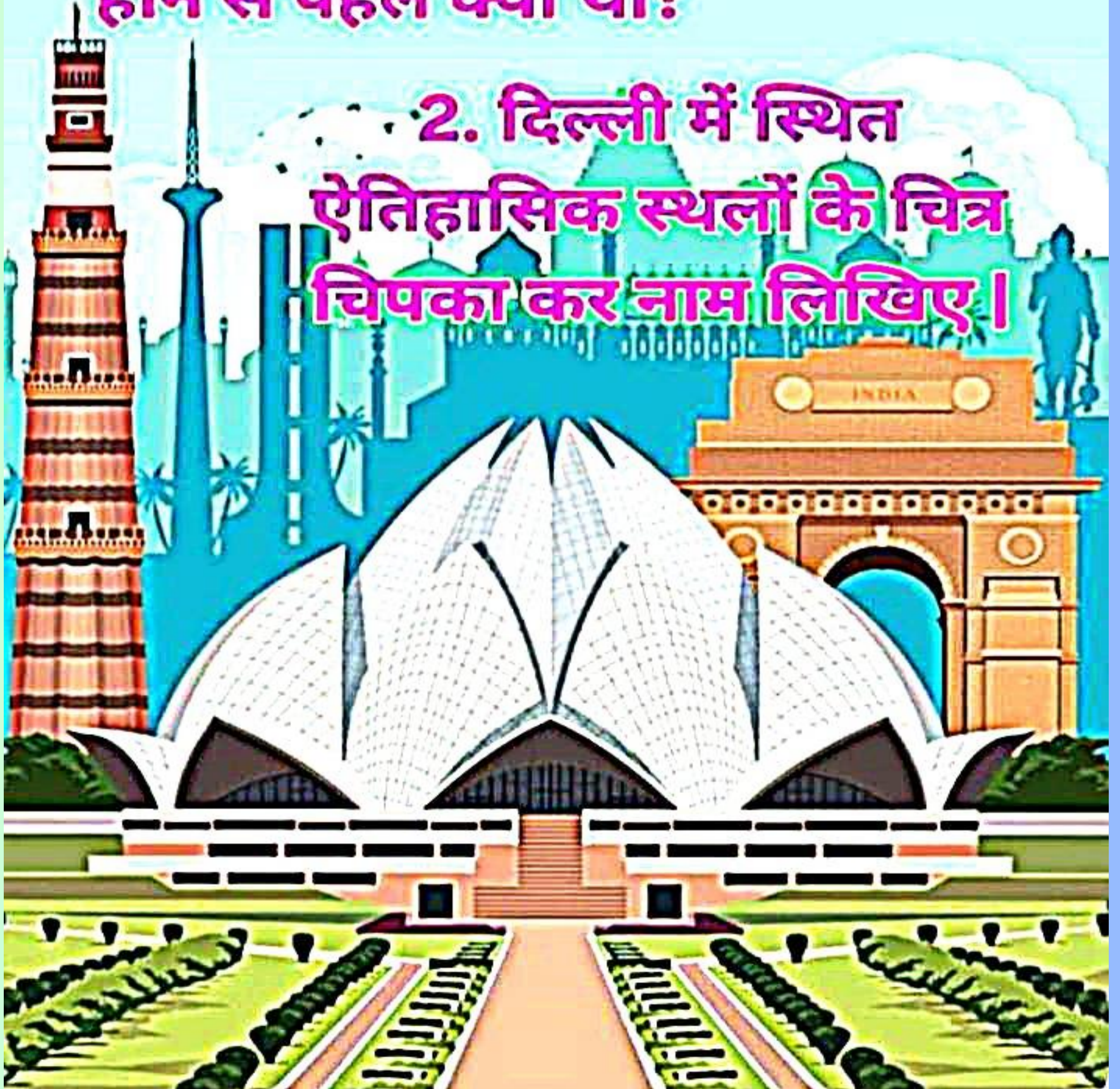

Write 5 healthy eating habits on A-4 size sheet.



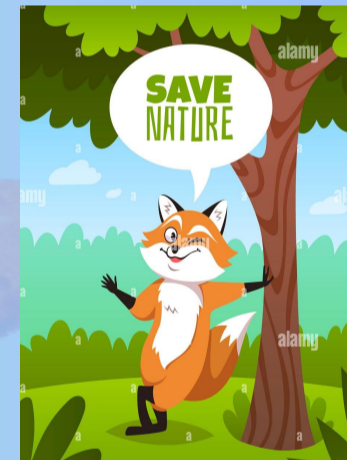
Activity 2
