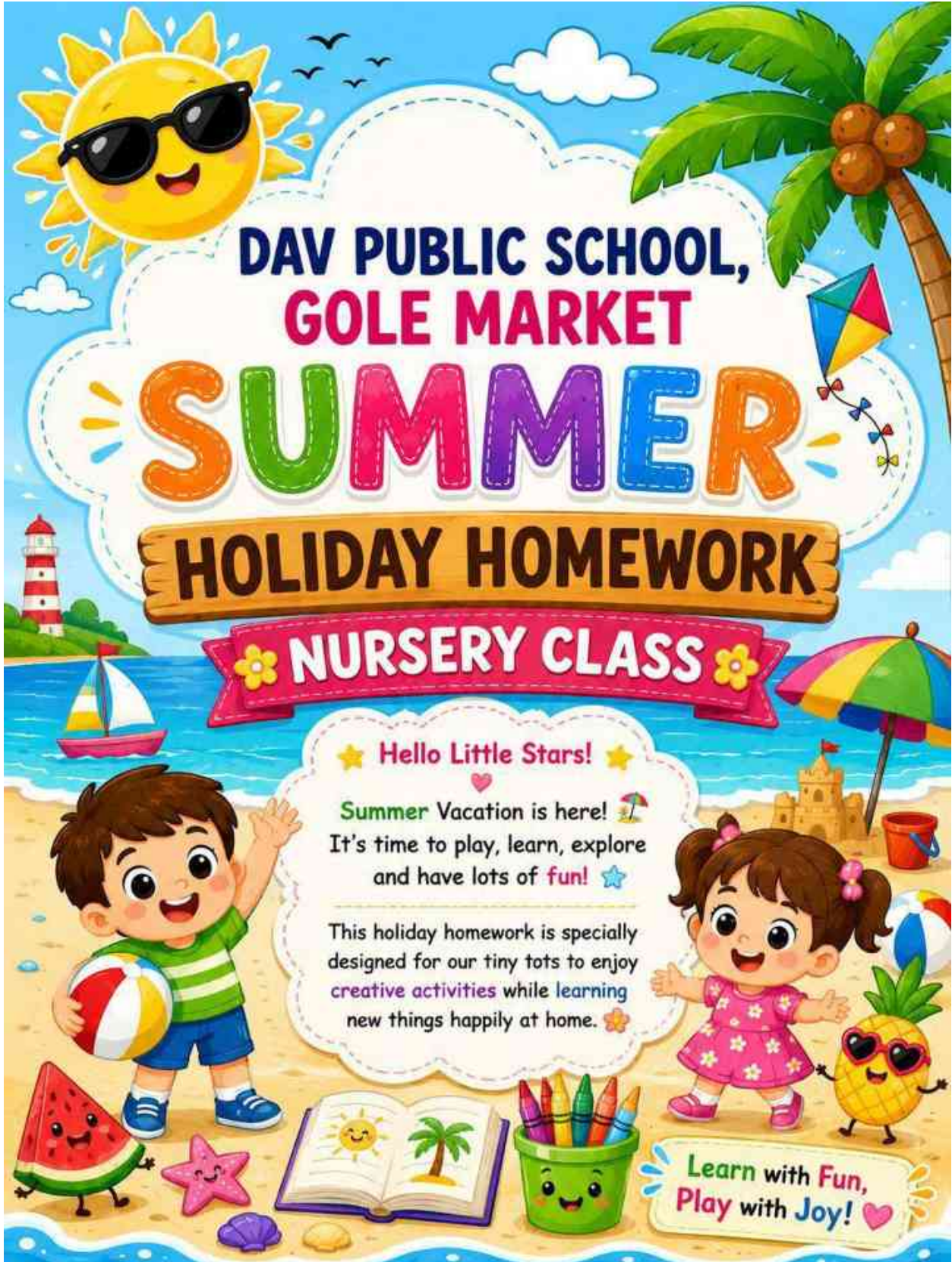

1. Square



All four sides are equal and straight.

2. Triangle



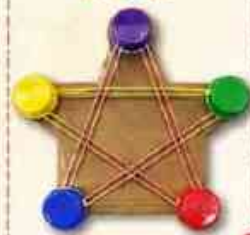
Three sides, three corners!

3. House



A triangle roof and a square body.

4. Star



Five points, one bright star!

2. Maze Ball Activity




MATERIALS REQUIRED

- Cardboard tray / Shoe box
- Ice cream sticks or straws
- Small ball or marble
- Glue
- Colour paper or paints
- Decorative items (stickers, flowers, glitter, etc.)



STEPS TO MAKE THE MAZE

1 Take a tray or cardboard box.



2 Paste colourful paper inside to decorate the base.



3 Arrange ice cream sticks/straws to create different paths and turns like a maze.



4 Leave a START and FINISH point.



5 Stick all the pieces carefully using glue.



6 Place the ball inside and enjoy the game!



HOW TO PLAY



Tilt and move the tray slowly to guide the ball from the starting point to the finish point without touching the walls of the maze.

HOW TO DO


- 1** Take a cardboard and paste 5 coloured bottle caps in a row.



- 2** Paste another row of the same 5 colours below.


- 3** Draw dotted lines to show the match.


- 4** Use rubber bands to match the same colours.


- 5** Or place matching objects like buttons, beads or pom-poms.


- 6** All colours matched! Great Job!



TIPS FOR PARENTS



- Encourage children to name each colour while matching.
- Make it fun by timing the activity or turning it into a game.

Make a fruit basket or vegetable garden using all your clay models and display it beautifully!

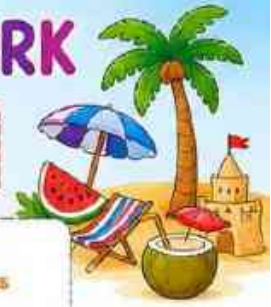

Fun Science Experiment



Balloon Blowing Activity



Blow the balloon through the **straw** and watch it **fly** in the sky!

Materials Needed:

- 1 Balloon
- 1 Straw
- Tape



How to Do:

1



Take a balloon.

2



Fix the mouth of the balloon tightly on one end of the straw using tape.

3



Blow air through the straw to inflate the balloon.

4



Leave the straw. The air will come out and the balloon will fly in the sky!

What Happened?

When we blow air into the balloon, it fills up with **air**. When we release it, the **air** rushes out and pushes the balloon forward. That's why the balloon flies!

Fun Activity

Magic Pictures

Cover the picture with a coloured transparent sheet. When we put a piece of paper in the shape of a torch, the base pictures will be visible!

Materials Needed:

- Colourful base picture (Jungle/Aquatic/Sky theme)
- Coloured transparent sheet
- Cardboard or frame
- White paper
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Tape



How to Make:

1



Take a colourful base picture and fix it on the cardboard or in a frame.

2



Cover it with a coloured transparent sheet and secure it with tape.

3



Cut a torch shape in a white paper.

4



Place the paper on the sheet. The picture will be visible only in the torch shape!

How It Works?

The coloured transparent sheet acts like a filter. It blocks the light. When we make a hole in the shape of a torch, light passes through that opening and we can see the picture clearly in that shape!

Fun Science Activity

Musical Bottle Activity



Let's make **music** with bottles!
Different water levels make
different **sounds**.

Tap the
bottles and
enjoy the
music!

Materials Needed

- 5 - 6 empty bottles (same size)
- Water
- Food colour (optional)
- Spoon or stick (to tap)



What Happens?

When we tap the bottles,
the air inside vibrates.
Changing the amount of
water changes the vibrations
and makes different sounds.



How to Make

- 1 Take 5 - 6 empty bottles.
- 2 Fill each bottle with different amounts of water.
- 3 Add food colour to make it colourful (optional).
- 4 Tap the bottles gently with a spoon or stick.
- 5 Listen to the different musical sounds!



What We Learn

- Sound is produced by vibrations.
- Water level changes the pitch of sound.
- Science can be fun and musical!

FUN SCIENCE ACTIVITY

BALLOON ROCKET EXPERIMENT



Blow it up... Let it go...
Watch your rocket **zoom!**



MATERIALS NEEDED

- 1 Balloon
- 1 Straw
- String (about 3–4 metres)
- Tape
- 2 Chairs



HOW TO MAKE

- 1 Thread the string through the straw.



- 2 Tie the string tightly between two chairs.



- 3 Blow up the balloon (do not tie it).



- 4 Tape the mouth of the balloon to the straw.



- 5 Let go of the balloon and watch your rocket zoom!



HOW DOES IT WORK?

When air rushes out of the balloon, it pushes the balloon forward. This is called **action and reaction!**



WHAT WE LEARN

- ★ Air can create force.
- ★ Forces can make things move.
- ★ Science is fun all around!

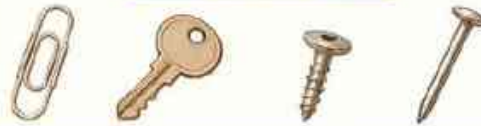
MAGNETIC HUNT
